

ONE DAY TOUR

- Meet at the hotel and set off for a day exploring the Langhe
- Visit to Pollenzo, an ancient town of Roman origin, and tour of the Agenzia, formerly the private residence of King Carlo Alberto of Savoy, restored in 2004 and now home to the University of Gastronomic Sciences and the Wine Bank. The royal estate was recognized as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1997
- Continue on to La Morra for a brief stop at the Belvedere viewpoint, offering an open-air map of the Langhe's vineyards
- Visit to the Cordero di Montezemolo winery in the Frazione Annunziata for a guided tasting and tour of the winery
- Continue to the town of Barolo for a wander through the streets of the historic town that gave its name to one of the world's most famous wines and a visit to the historic Borgogno winery
- Continue to Grinzane for lunch at the castle
- Visit to the city of Alba, the Langhe's cultural and economic hub. Free time for walking around the beautiful historic center
- Visit to the Laboratorio di Resistenza Dolciaria pastry shop, where owner Federico Molinari will lead a tasting of two of his typical specialties, hazelnut spread and hazelnut cake
- Visit to the Marchesi di Gresy winery at the Martinenga estate to discover one of Barbaresco's best wines
